We are allowed by law to hold and use this information as long as we keep to very strict rules.



We may share information about you with others who also provide you with health care such as the hospital and out of hours providers



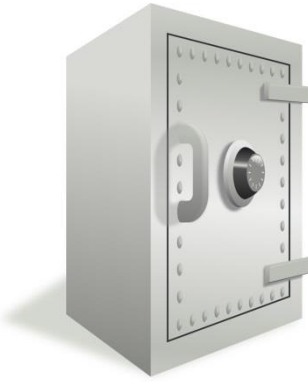
We also share information with health authorities and the Care Quality Commission if asked to do so for payment and inspection purposes



When we do research or audits that are shared outside the practice, nobody can identify you from the information we give.



We might have to share information without your permission to save your life or if you or someone else is at risk of abuse



We keep your information safe and secure. We try to make sure it is all correct and up-to-date.
