Chanel discussed the Social Prescribing Project (DES Proactive social prescribing)

CR: Me and Shamina will be proactively contacting Diabetic patients from the 1st of October, who are diagnosed within the last two years to offer support. All social prescribers in London will be doing this project but they can choose their target group.

The aim is to support those who may have become inactive during the lockdown and link them back to the services that have reopened. We found this useful when we called patients for weight management in the summer and had a very positive response.

Dr CJ: This is very good as we will still be referring patients to them but they are also reaching out.

D CJ reminded the group that Dr DeSliva has left to do locum work.

Short discussion about patient access, how to use it, ordering repeat prescriptions and using the NHS app instead.

ML: I can't see any appointments on my patient access.

TL: There is one medication that I can't order as a repeat and need to contact reception. Why can't this be changed?

CR: We can see if a receptionist can join our meeting to explain these queries and show us a simple run-through if possible.

ML: As I'm new to the practice it would be nice to know how many locum GPs and nurses we have and who are they.

CR: The updated picture board is still in process however all the staff details are on the Claremont Clinic website
