

Now you can see a doctor on a Saturday

A Saturday service is now available as part of a pilot project involving surgeries in Whitstable, Canterbury and Faversham.

From Saturday 7 November 2015, doctors from practices in each of the towns and Invicta Health will be working together to offer GP appointments from 8am to 8pm.

The pilot project will run until end of March 2016 and will operate from the following locations:

- Estuary View Medical Centre, Boorman Way, Whitstable, CT5 3SE
- Northgate Medical Practice, 1 Northgate, Canterbury, CT1 1WL
- Faversham Medical Practice, Bank Street, Faversham, ME13 8QR (8am—2pm)
- Newton Place Surgery, Newton Rd, Faversham, ME13 8FH (2pm—8pm)

Appointments can be booked directly by contacting reception at your registered GP surgery and you can be seen at any of the sites specified above. There will also be a limited number of walk-in appointments available.

Appointments are limited and are for both urgent and routine problems. When all available appointments are booked, you will be asked to contact 111 to access other appropriate healthcare.
