Pharmacy First is a scheme available from participating pharmacies for patients who are suffering from a common ailment and do not pay for their prescriptions (exempt patients and those with pre-payment certificates).

Patients can get advice and treatment for a range of common ailments free of charge from participating pharmacies and no appointment is necessary.
